AGRSS Announces First Five Registered Training Programs

The Auto Glass Replacement Safety Standard (AGRSS) Council announced that it has registered its first five training programs. The announcement was made today at the group's annual conference at the Mandalay Bay Convention Center in Las Vegas.

The first five AGRSS-registered training programs are as follows:

- Automotive Glass Consultants;
- Dow Automotive;
- Independent Glass Association;
- Shat R Proof Corp.; and
- SIKA Corp.

The companies had to submit the elements of their training program to the AGRSS Council for review and they determined that the programs comply with the AGRSS standard.

AGRSS is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to the safe replacement of auto glass. AGRSS was founded and is supported by companies in the auto glass replacement industry that keep safe installation as their primary goal. The Council is also accredited by the American National Standard Institute (ANSI) – a standard development organization – and has developed North America's only auto glass replacement standard, the AGRSS Standard (ANSI/AGRSS 002-2002). The AGRSS Standard addresses procedures, education and product performance.
