Whenever you need the glass in your car replaced, you'll want to look for this sign.

It means that the auto glass company replacing your glass is registered with the Automotive Glass Replacement Safety Standards (AGRSS) Council. AGRSS-registered companies have made a written commitment to install auto glass in accordance with the Automotive Glass Replacement Safety Standard, the world's only standard for proper auto glass installation. AGRSS-registered shops have also undergone a detailed application process and must undertake a self-audit of their policies and procedures every year. This symbol means that every employee in the whole company is committed to following the Standard—not just one or two employees.

Your windshield does much more than just protect you from weather and insects. Your windshield also acts as a safety shield for the passengers in the vehicle itself. Your windshield and side window glass are part of your vehicle's passenger restraint system and must be replaced by trained technicians. Airbags to deploy from the windshield also aids in occupant retention, keeping passengers in the car in the case of an accident.

So make sure you choose a company that is registered with AGRSS for any of your auto glass replacement needs. Look for this logo at quality glass shops, or visit our website at www.safewindshields.com. Your windshield is a safety shield. Make sure it is replaced by a company that has a commitment to safety.
