## **AGRSS STANDARD ATTRACTS INTERNATIONAL ATTENTION**

The new Auto Glass Replacement Safety Standard, developed by the Automotive Glass Replacement Safety Standards (AGRSS) Council, Inc., is gaining widespread interest in the international auto safety community. The Standard was the topic of a recent presentation at Glass Processing Days in Tampere, Finland. The well-known technical conference, sponsored by Tamglass Engineering Oy, attracted more than 900 glass industry delegates from around the world.

“Understanding North America's New Auto Glass Safety Standard” was also a popular seminar at Glass Expo Pacific Northwest, held two weeks ago in Vancouver, B.C. Officials from a number of Canadian organizations were in attendance and expressed interest in a close working relationship with the Standards developer, the AGRSS Council.

“There has been a lot of interest in the Standard and a lot of questions about it from the audiences at these events,” said Debra Levy, publisher of **AGRR** magazine and the speaker at both sessions. “It's exciting to see the AGRSS Standard being recognized and acknowledged throughout the world.”

The Automotive Glass Replacement Safety Standards Council, Inc., is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to the safe replacement of auto glass. AGRSS was founded and is supported by companies in the auto glass replacement industry that keep safe installation as their primary goal.
